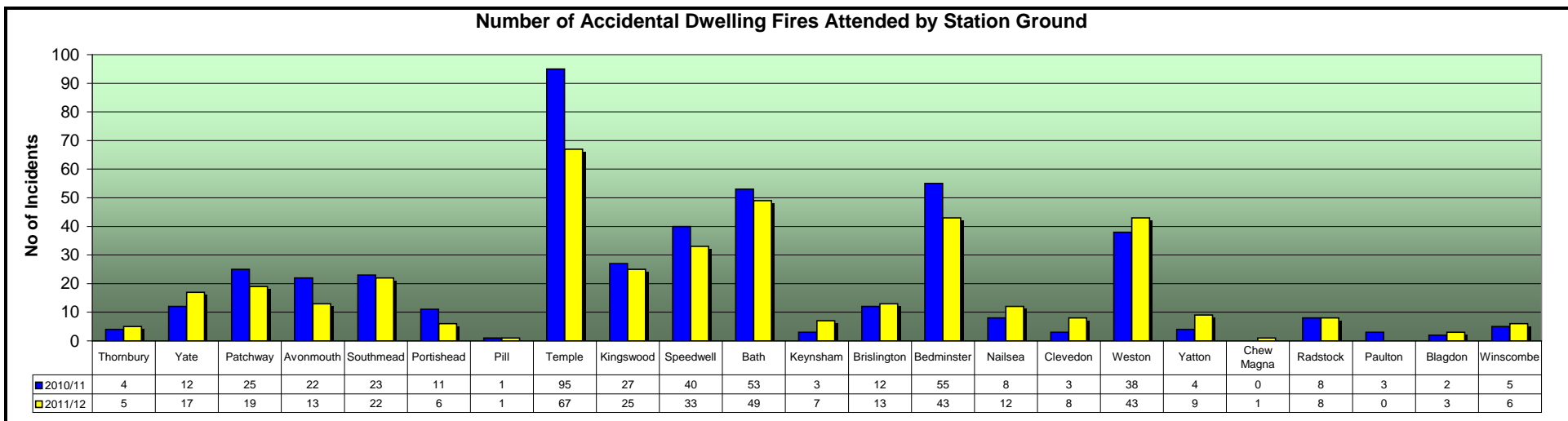
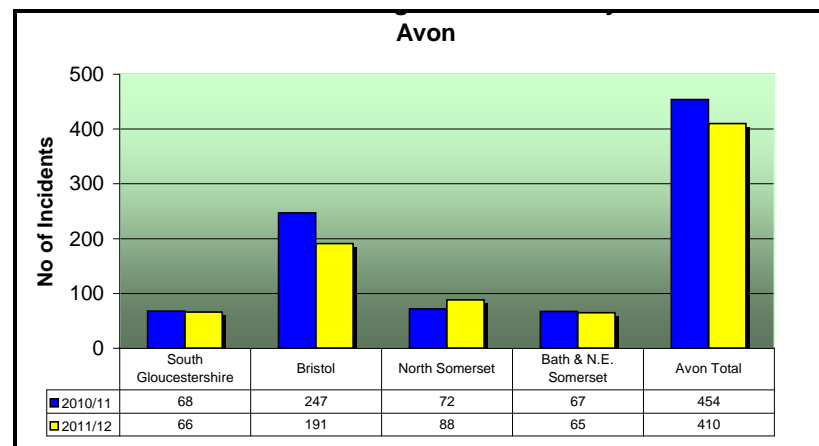
Neither the phone call or the visit will cost you a penny and may save your life.
