

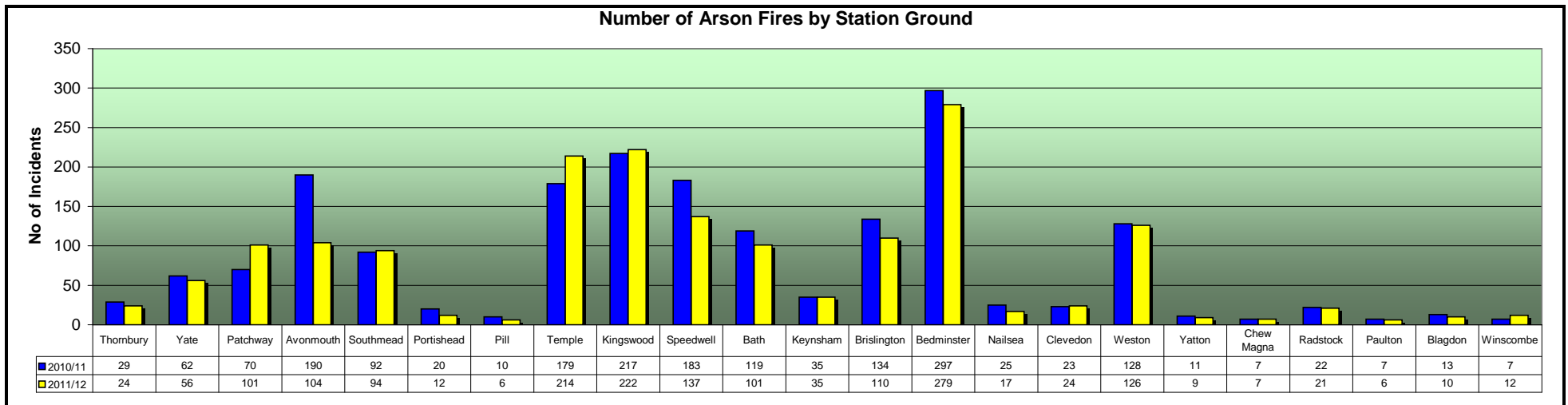
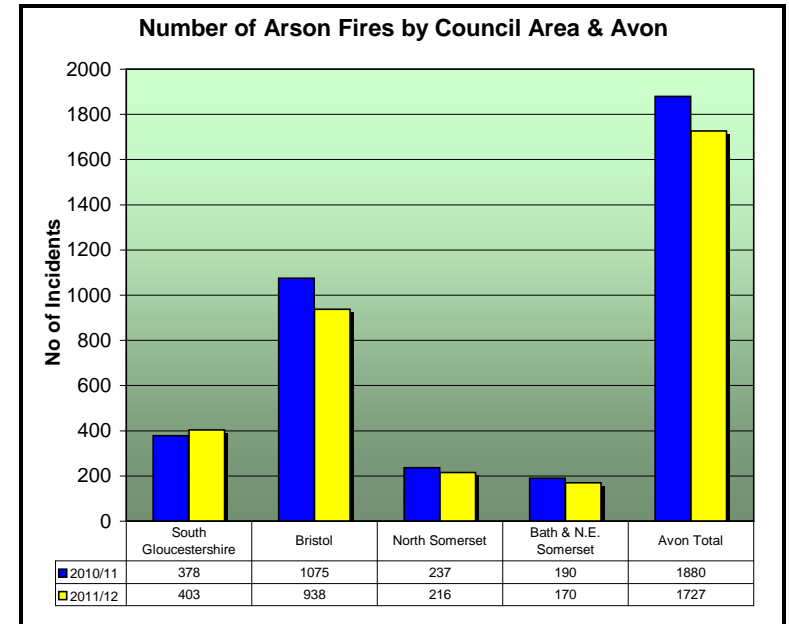
Deliberate Arson Fires
