

**Avon and Somerset Local Resilience Forum

Terms of Reference (V1.1)

Name

1. The group will work to the Avon and Somerset Local Resilience Forum (A&S LRF) and will be known as the **A&S LRF Risk Assessment Working Group (RAWG)**.

Aims

2. The aims of the A&S LRF Risk Assessment Working Group will be to:
 - (a) carry out a risk assessment of the Avon and Somerset area and report the findings to the Avon and Somerset Local Resilience Forum;
 - (b) produce and monitor the A&S LRF community risk register (CRR) and to make recommendations to the A&S LRF in respect of priorities and future actions as determined on a multi-agency basis by the A&S LRF; and
 - (c) maintain a dynamic overview of the strategic risk profile of the A&S LRF area through scheduled and where required, ad-hoc meetings and report the results to the A&S LRF in the most appropriate manner; and
 - (d) arrange for the formal publication of the A&S LRF community risk register in November each year (or earlier if required as a result of significant changes in the strategic risk profile as identified in para. (c) above).
